– refers to only one object

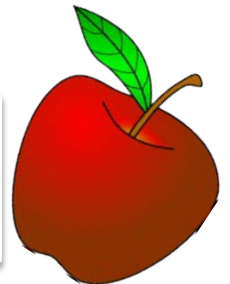
Example:

How many puppies?



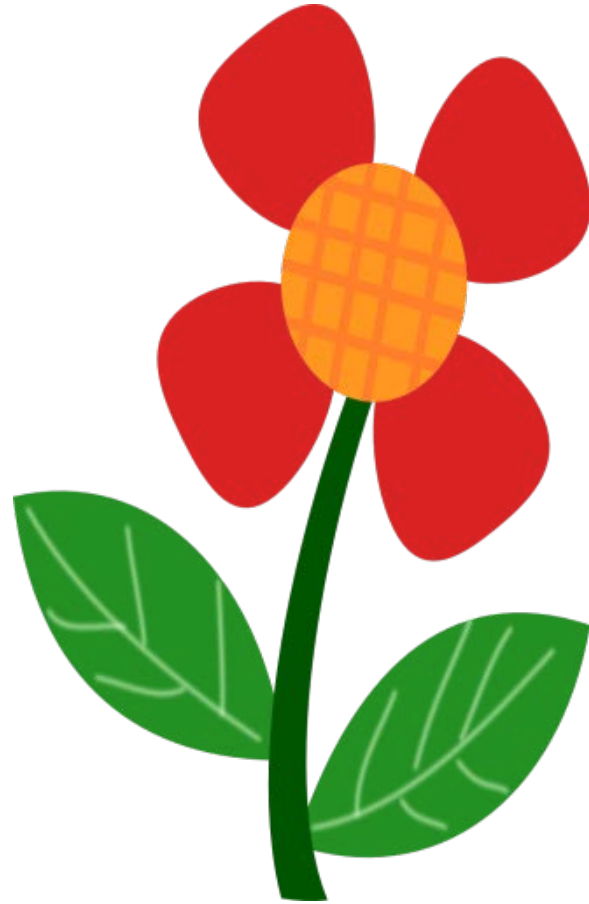
There is one puppy.

There is one apple.



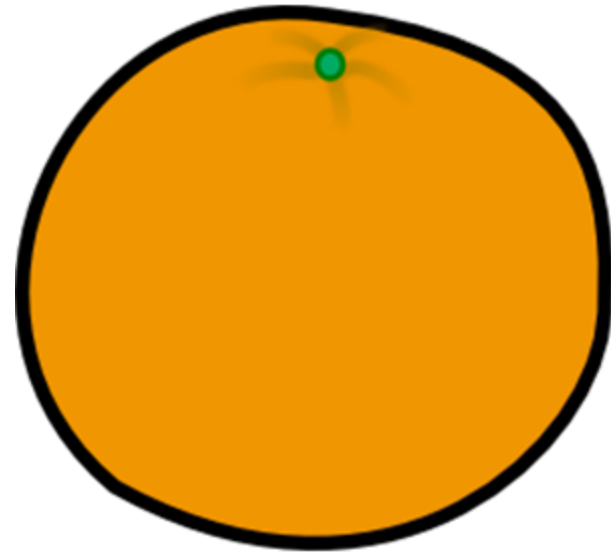
How many flowers?

– refers to two or many objects

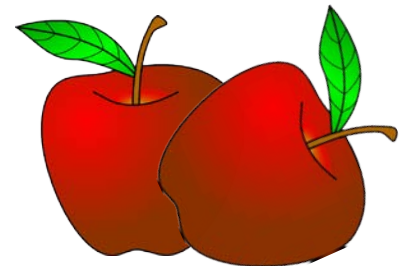
Example:

\_\_\_ books.



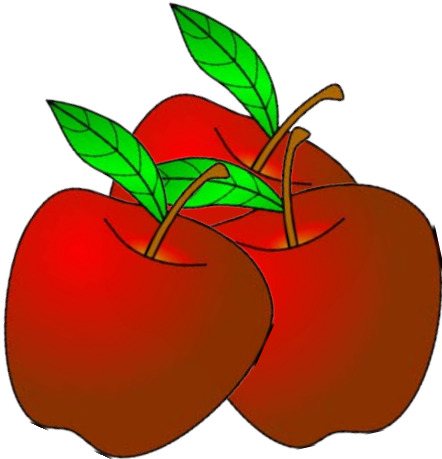

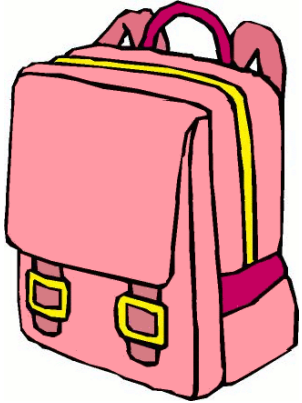
