<b>Title:</b>	Debate is Fun (Free conversation)
<b>Topic for Debate:</b>	<b>Nintendo should stop making warlike games</b>

**Introduction:** This lesson gives the student more speaking opportunities in expressing his thoughts that would improve his/her speaking and reasoning skills. The student would also learn various expressions for agreeing and disagreeing.



Resolved: **That Nintendo should stop making warlike games.**



# IDEA GENERATOR

## Pros

- Both experimental and non-experimental research have shown that violent video games damage young people playing them in both the short and long term, leading to criminal and anti-social behaviour.
- Parents are unaware of how violent the video games are. Parents often use video games as a way to keep their children entertained while they are busy minding their own business.
- Modern video games cannot be fairly compared to traditional childhood play.

## Cons

- Many researchers (Ask, 1999; Funk, 1993, 1995; Provenzo, 1991) conclude that there is no causal link between violent video games and aggressive behaviour.
- Society has decided to embrace violent video games, which as a result are very profitable.
- Not only is it wrong for the government to take censorship-like steps against violent video games but it is also impossible to do so effectively.

## See for example:

**Person A:** “In my opinion, I believe that Nintendo games make kids violent because of its warlike content that is why they should stop making those kinds of games from now on.”

**Person B:** “I strongly disagree with the proposition since I believe that the warlike content of Nintendo games doesn’t affect the behavior of kids.”

<p><b>Expressing agreement</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I agree with you 100 percent.</li> <li>• I couldn't agree with you more.</li> <li>• That's so true.</li> <li>• That's for sure.</li> <li>• <b>(slang)</b> Tell me about it!</li> <li>• You're absolutely right.</li> <li>• Absolutely.</li> <li>• That's exactly how I feel.</li> <li>• Exactly.</li> <li>• I'm afraid I agree with James.</li> <li>• I have to side with Dad on this one.</li> <li>• No doubt about it.</li> <li>• <b>(agree with negative statement)</b> Me neither.</li> <li>• <b>(weak)</b> I suppose so./I guess so.</li> <li>• You have a point there.</li> <li>• I was just going to say that.</li> </ul>
